1	Introductions and Safety Moment
2	Review of previous minutes
	The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and accepted as a true record.
3	Ferrybridge 'C' Update
	MC apologised on MG's behalf that he was unable to make the meeting today. He updated that unit 3 and unit 4 are currently in an outage period, and are due back online at the end of July and beginning of October respectively.
4	SINIAT update (formerly Lafarge)
	CB updated that the site had achieved being one year accident free, and the site was holding a celebration event later in the year to celebrate this with the staff. The Ferrybridge site is carrying out trials to see if they can recycle their own waste products, instead of sending them to their Bristol site as they do currently, which would increase the environmental performance of the site. The plant is running well and is in regular communication with WMDC, who have no concerns.
5	Multifuel 1 Update
5.1	New members of the team
	CD said that the Financial Controller and Plant Chemist had started in their roles as of June 2014. 10 more operational staff (including Shift and Day Team Leaders, Mechanical Engineer, EC&I Engineer and Planner) are due to start on 1 September 2014.
5.2	Planning and Permits
	JW updated that Planning Condition 54 (noise) has been discharged. An application for extended working hours and deliveries up to the end of August has been approved. An outline programme for the golf course, (PC15) has been submitted to Sport England and Planning Condition 62 (Odour) has been submitted. JW said that as this was not her area of expertise, if anyone had any questions on this area, they should address them to her so that she could get the questions answered by the most appropriate person.
5.3	Construction Update
	<p>Alex Shenton gave a construction update on behalf of HZI. The civils works are now nearing completion and commissioning is expected to begin in Q4 of 2014. AS updated that there had been no noise complaints reported to the site this quarter. MG said that her, and some of the other Oakhill residents, have experienced noise. AS, JW and RL encouraged anybody who has any concerns about noise, lighting etc from the site to report it immediately using the telephone number given in the minutes, or on the website. If the site has times, dates etc of any issues, it can be investigated thoroughly and the results fed back to local residents. The site currently has permission to work 24 hours a day, but activities that could be noisy are limited during evening and night time hours. Noise levels are monitored constantly at the site perimeter.</p> <p>RN asked what type of activities are carried out at night? AS confirmed that it is usually radiography, which is a silent activity. RN asked if the site carried out risk assessments for noisy activities? AS confirmed that risk assessments are carried out, and high impact activities are not allowed at night. It was explained once again that any issues should be reported as soon as possible to the site</p>

	JW updated that the specification for the course was being developed and procurement was underway. These activities will be ongoing until the end of this year.
6	Ferrybridge Multifuel 2
	JW updated that approximately 2500 newsletters distributed w/c 2 June to update on how consultation has helped to influence the project. The CLG was also sent an electronic copy and a copy of the newsletter is available on the website for the wider public to access. The FM2 team are aiming to submit the DCO application beginning of July. The DCO examination process is expected to take place later this year, which will be advertised widely in the local area nearer the time.
