

JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Fuel Ash Operator
Reports To: Day Team Leader
Location: Ferrybridge Multifuel

Job Summary

The Fuel/Ash Operator undertakes operational duties within the facility, including all phases of fuel receipt, ash handling operations and bulk chemical deliveries.

This includes managing weighbridge operations duties, to ensure only authorised vehicles are permitted across the weighbridge, and to operate the waste and ash cranes to maintain a clear tipping area in the pit accommodating incoming waste delivery vehicles.

This role will be worked on a rotating shift pattern consisting of early and late shifts, Monday to Friday with occasional Saturday mornings, overtime may be a requirement in order to meet operational demands, particularly on weekends.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Monitor and direct fuel (refuse) trucks to allocated bays on Tipping Floor.
- Screen loads for unacceptable waste and fills out appropriate inspection reports.
- Assist Crane Operator in implementation of good pit management.
- Maintain a clear tipping floor area, ensuring any obstacles are removed or waste that is unacceptable is segregated for subsequent disposal, and that traffic flows smoothly.
- Operation of the waste and ash cranes to maintain an effective bunker profile.
- Directing vehicle deliveries of bulk chemical supplies and liquid fuel and ensures that approved procedures are followed to ensure safe delivery.
- Assisting in the operation of Air Pollution Control residues (APCR) conveying and loading equipment.
- Safely and effectively operating heavy equipment in the course of daily operations.
- Performing routine maintenance checks on mobile equipment and reports malfunctions.
- Operating mobile plant including, but not limited to, industrial forklifts and other mobile equipment.
- Manage weighbridge operations duties to ensure only authorised vehicles are permitted across the weighbridge and ensuring transfer of waste notices are completed.
- Check Duty of Care documentation with each load
- Carry out Waste Acceptance Criteria spot checks, and cross reference against waste transfer notes.
- Liaise with site staff and management to continually improve the operation and profitability of the site
- Assist and give guidance to customers and site users. For example, directing vehicles, reminding customers to wear PPE etc and issuing near miss reports as required
- Report breaches of user rules or safety instructions using Company procedures
- When required, supports the shift operations staff to ensure continuous operations
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Day Team Leader and works overtime as required for the role.

Supervisory Responsibilities

There are no supervisory responsibilities associated with this role.

Qualifications & Experience

- Educated to GCSE level.
- Previous experience in a similar role is desirable but not essential.
- Licensed to drive fork lift trucks, front end loaders and other mobile plant.

Competencies

- Excellent communication skills.
- Able to work independently and take initiative where required.
- Demonstrates awareness of health and safety issues.
- Able to cope with numerous issues simultaneously and capable of prioritising tasks accordingly.
- Maintains a positive attitude.
- Able to work under pressure.
- Contributes to a positive team spirit and enhances plant morale.
- Accepts both positive and negative constructive feedback from others and makes adjustments to performance based on such feedback.
- Treats people with respect.
- Works ethically and with integrity at all times.

Work Environment

The normal setting for this job is internal and external areas. Listed below are key points regarding environmental demands and work environment of the job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of the job.

- Required to work a shift pattern consisting of early shifts / late shifts, predominantly Monday to Friday. Some weekend work required to suit business demands.
- Required to exert physical effort in handling objects less than 20 kg.
- Will be exposed to physical occupational risks (such as cuts, burns, exposure to toxic chemicals, etc) and must be capable of assessing these risks and applying suitable preventative measures to prevent injury.
- Exposure to a physical environment which involves dirt, odours, noise, weather extremes or similar elements.
